Basic Module 1 (BM1)

- You need to pick three courses in total
 - Each course is counting 3CP, the combined final module exam for those three courses will count another 3CP
- You need to choose one course per thematic field
 - One out of History or Culture
 - One out of Economy or Society
 - One out of Politics or Law
- All core courses are on introductory level no previous knowledge required

- German courses will be registered on Klips through the German department directly – registering instructions will be passed on from Exchange-to-Cologne dependent on your initial choices.
- As a CGSP participant you may pick to enroll for one or two classes (pre-semester and semester or just either of them). For obtaining the CGSP certificate it is mandatory that you complete at least one German language course successfully (BM2). A second course can be counted towards the EM.
- Please note that your initial choice is binding and you will not be asked at a later date if you would like to continue on after a pre-semester course.
- German courses will appear on Klips, but delayed



Elective Module (EM)

- German courses to be counted for the EM do not need to be registered for on Klips (procedure is the same as for BM2)
- Faculty courses register via Klips
- Core courses register via Klips
- You will need a total of (at least) 9CP for the elective module
 E.g.: One additional BM1 course and two 3CP-faculty courses

KLIPS 2.0

- KLIPS is the campus management system of the UoC https://klips2.uni-koeln.de/co/ee/ui/ca2/app/desktop/#/login?\$ctx=lang=en
- You need to have activated your student account (Klips access is equivalent to your student mail account information)
- You need student status (log-in with your smail user name) in order to register for courses!
- Course registration is possible during the so-called registrationphases (announced on our website)
- You can also change your course registration during this phase (meaning drop courses and register new ones)

- Log-in with your private/home university email adress: You can log-in during the application process and have limited access to the Klips-functions (e.g. to check your enrollment status)
- Log-in with your uni-koeln account (*yourname@smail.uni-koeln.de*): You will receive that account after the enrollment is fully complete (e.g. semester fee needs to be paid in full). You need to activate that account prior to using it for Klips.

The module is intended to introduce the students to the permanent judicial organ established by the European Convention on Human Rights: the European Court of Human Rights. After providing a historical background on the Council of Europe and the European Convention of Human Rights in relation to the Court, the module focuses on the Court's structure, jurisdiction, and the conduct of proceedings, providing an understanding of key doctrinal concepts that are adopted by the Court. It also considers a selection of the most important cases the Court has dealt with and which impact positively the development of international human rights law.
