8th IMPRS Uncertainty Topics Workshop/ Cologne Doctoral Workshop on Cognition, Coordination, Cooperation, and Competition

The Workshop is organized jointly by the Cologne Graduate School in Management, Economics and Social Sciences (CGS) and the International Max Planck Research School on Adapting Behavior in a Fundamentally Uncertain World (IMPRS-Uncertainty).

It is an interdisciplinary event where researchers from Economics, Law and Psychology meet to exchange their recent research ideas.

The main objective is to give doctoral students an opportunity to present their work to fellow students and senior researchers. In addition, there will be lectures on selected topics by senior researchers.

The selected topics have a focus on the following questions:

- Markets, Political Institutions and the Judicial System all seek to coordinate the activities of numerous individuals. How robust are our predictions on the outcomes of that coordination?
- Are they sensitive to specific models of human behavior?
- How can cooperation be generated in social dilemma situations? How does this work in theory?
- How does it work in the lab? How does it work in the field?
- What are the conditions for competitions to yield good outcomes?
- Under what conditions are competitive institutions evolutionary stable?

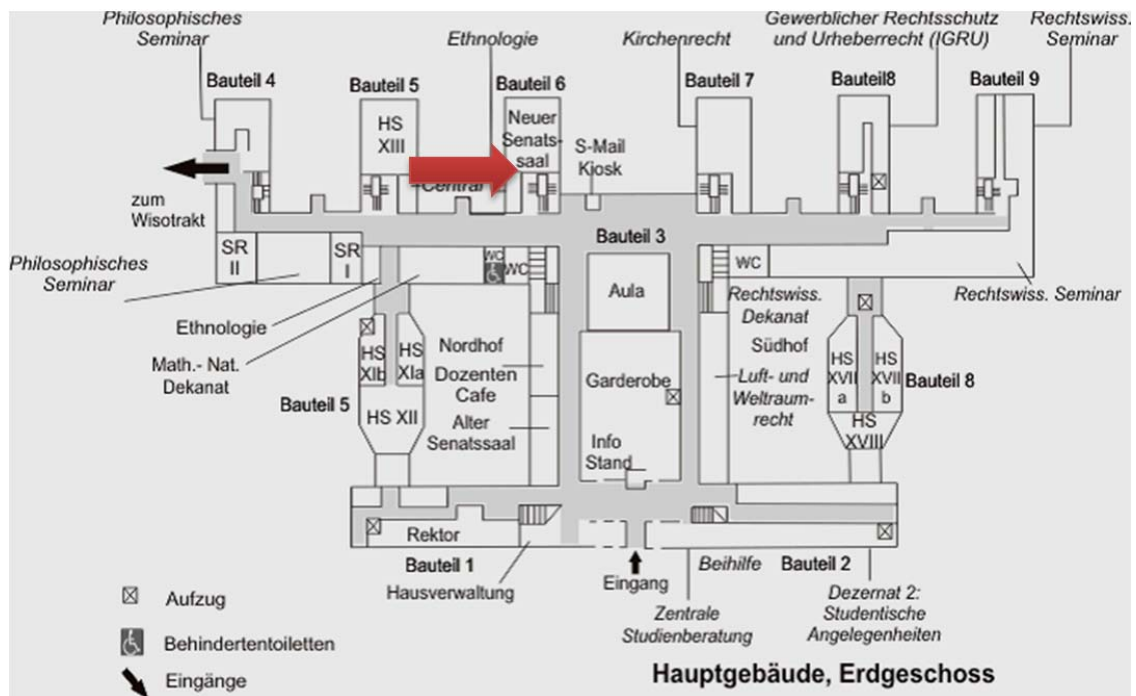
