Health Insurance

Pre-Semester

(March or September)

If you are travelling to Cologne before the start of the semester, we recommend to take out a travel health insurance.

Semester (October or April) You need a proof of health insurance coverage from a German statutory health insurer or – if you are already insured in your home country – an exemption certificate from a German statutory health insurer for your enrolment. A German statutory health insurance costs approx. 120 EUR per month.

Visa Requirements It is your responsibility to familiarise yourself with the visa conditions for entry to Germany before you arrive. You must apply for a residence permit within 90 days of your arrival.

Semester Fee The UoC does not charge any tuition fees. However, all students must pay a social contribution fee of around 320 EUR per semester. This fee also includes the "Deutschlandsemesterticket" – is a personal season ticket and issued exclusively as a personalised digital ticket. It is valid throughout Germany on local public transport.

Finding accomodation is tough and demanding for students. We strongly recommend to apply for room in a students dormitory of the Kölner Studierendenwerk (KSTW) right after having received the admission letter. Furthermore, please look for housing options for yourself on the private housing market as well. The Division International Affairse can assist you in this matter.
