Summer School "Urbanizing India"

The summer school aims at providing an international, interdisciplinary platform to bring together young scholar from India and Germany to exchange and discuss intensively about new concepts on recent urbanization processes in India from different theoretical and practical perspectives. The global urbanization processes – fostered in their consequences by the Indian New Economic Policy – also in India leads to deep ecological and socio-economic transformation.

The summer school program will address key topics such as main processes, challenges, drivers, actors and chances of urban transformation in India, will contextualize the processes and their implications and will focus on solutions and strategies to improve future urbanization in respect to the aims of SDG11 and the New Urban Agenda. Further, the program will include leadership training, methodological reflections as well as academic argumentation and writing skills.

The program combines different formats of teaching, exchange and discussion with site visits, expert interviews and practical fieldwork. It encourages the establishment of networks between young international scholars and academic trustbuilding beyond borders.

General overview:

The University of Cologne offers in the field of Geography and related subjects:

- 10 PhD student mobilities for the Summer School "Urbanizing India" (from UoC to BVU) with a duration of 10 days.

The summer school will take place at BVU from October 27th until November 5th, 2023.

Tuition fees:

The receiving institution will not ask the grantee to pay fees for tuition, registration, examinations or for access to laboratory and library facilities during his/her mobility period. Nevertheless, the grantee may be charged a fee on the same basis as local students for costs such as student unions and the use of study-related materials or equipment.
