



Internship at Linnæus University, Sweden

Education and/or Teacher Training, Languages and Philological Sciences

The Department of Languages at Linnæus University in Växjö, Sweden, is looking for interns every term.

Our department educates students who major or minor in Language Studies, e.g., in programmes within culture and communication studies, as well as teacher trainees. We are a language department with 40 employees, and we are looking for motivated staff members to support us in our daily work in the subjects of English, Spanish or German. We offer one position in each of the three subjects. The general tasks for the interns include teaching assistance and administrative work. The internship would ideally be 4-5 months long in the periods from September to December or January to May, but this is negotiable.

Work Tasks:

- Assistance in class
- Assistance with administrative tasks and organising events, and maintaining contacts with schools in the region
- Public relations
- Helping to design new courses (e.g., online courses)
- Help our teachers and researchers with their tasks

We are looking for a person:

- who is motivated, sociable and has an interest in didactics
- who likes to work both in a team and independently
- with knowledge of Swedish (although this is not a strict requirement)

We offer:

- help with finding a place to stay
- a workplace with inspiring and varied tasks at a modern and international university, located in beautiful Småland, where many go for vacation
- work with small groups of students
- the opportunity to get to know the country and its people
- Fika (the most important Swedish word for beginners)

Note that the internship is unpaid and that the intern should have health insurance, which is valid in Sweden. (Financial compensation can be granted through the Erasmus+ funding at your home university)
