Basic Module 1 (BM1)

12 CP

Choose **three core courses**.

One from each of the three thematic groups:

- 3 CP **History and Culture**
- 3 CP **Economy and Society**
- 3 CP **Politics and Law**
- 3 CP final exam

All core courses are on introductory level – no previous knowledge required.

Elective Module (EM)

9 CP

A variety of courses to choose from (incl. German Language Courses).

Basic Module 2 (BM2)

9 CP

German as a Foreign Language

Up to **two** German language courses per semester are free of charge.

- 1 Pre-semester Intensive course (20h/week) **and**
- 2 Regular semester German language course (6h/week)
- » tutored individual online learning for basic levels
- » the digital presemester course is available from abroad
- » online assessment test for course assignments

If more than one German language course is chosen the second one will count towards the Elective Module (EM).

30 CP

 - » only if 30 CP are achieved within one semester
- 2 **Transcript of Records**
