Basic Module 2 (BM2)

German as a Foreign Language

Up to **two** German language courses per semester are free of charge.

- Pre-semester Intensive course (20h/week)
 and
- Regular semester German language course (6h/week)
- » tutored individual online learning for basic levels
- » the digital presemester course is available from abroad
- » online assessment test for course asignments

If more than one German language course is chosen the second one will count towards the Elective Module (EM).
