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- ▶ **Academic Excellence:** custom-tailored courses in Contemporary European Studies and selected complementary courses from the university's course catalogue
  - ▶ **English-taught Courses:** introductory level - no previous knowledge of German is necessary in order to sign-up for the CGSP
  - ▶ **German Language Skills:** intensive German classes are an essential part of the curriculum (spot guaranteed) \*
  - ▶ **Certification:** earn academic credits, and receive a certificate and transcript upon successful completion of coursework
  - ▶ **Flexible Duration:** one semester, a full academic year, or the "early-leaver" options are available
  - ▶ **Intercultural Learning Environment:** classes are open to international and German students
  - ▶ **Keep your faculty:** you could be exclusively enrolled in the CGSP or get enrolled in a faculty at the same time as well
  - ▶ **Virtual option:** It is possible to study the entire semester virtually, if you can't come to Cologne

\* CGSP students are entitled to TWO German courses (pre-semester PLUS semester course is possible!)

# Basic Module 1 („core courses“)

- ▶ The Fundamentals of Public International Law and EU Law: Sources, Principles and Actors
- ▶ Between Utopia and Babylon: History of the European Union
- ▶ Europe 1900 - End and Beginning. From the Turn of the century to Modernism to War
- ▶ Democracy and the European Union
- ▶ Digitalisation and Sustainable Development in Europe and Beyond
- ▶ Introduction into Theories of European Integration

# Details „core courses“

- ▶ Core course can be chosen within the BM1 or the EM
- ▶ Registration: Request via email ECTS: 3 Credit Points per course
- ▶ Requirements:
  - ▶ Class minutes (once per semester)
  - ▶ Written performance as stated by the teacher (essay / presentation or equivalent performance – graded if chosen as a BM1 course)
  - ▶ Core course as an elective: class minutes and written performance, no exam

# Basic Module 2 (German courses)

- ▶ Pre-Semester course (9 ECTS)
  - ▶ Daily intensive course (5 x 4 hrs per week)
  - ▶ 8 March – 1 April 2021
- ▶ Semester course (9 ECTS)
  - ▶ Two days a week (6 hrs per week)
  - ▶ Start: 19 April 2021
- ▶ NOTE: CGSP students are entitled to two courses, instead of just one. If pre-semester course is counted in basic module 2, the semester course can count as elective module performance!

# Elective Module (course choices)

- ▶ CGSP courses
  - ▶ Core course not counted towards the Basic Module 1 (3 ECTS each)
  - ▶ Intercultural Issues in Academia (intercultural competence – 3 ECTS)
- ▶ German course (if pre-semester course was counted towards the Basic Module 2)
