


ILIAS:

ILIAS the learning management system used at the University of Cologne. It is used to provide the students with materials for the class, for communication and sometimes for assessment (e.g. uploading homework).

You can use it once you have successfully activated your Klips 2.0 account. Please note that it can take up to 24 hours after your Klips registration for this platform to get activated.


