

#### Staff



Excellence on CO<sub>2</sub> Management with the University of Düsseldorf), Our
dynamic Universe (Dynaverse with the University of Bonn) and
Language Challenges (University of Cologne). The final decision on
the draft proposals will be made in February 2024.

• **Katja Restel** has been the coordinator of the recently established <u>Open Science Center Cologne</u> since October 2023. She is responsible for implementing and developing Open Science principles at the UoC. 

#### Collaborative Research Centers

The University of Cologne has successfully acquired new Collaborative Research Centers (CRCs) in <u>May</u> and <u>November</u> 2023. Beginning in April 2024, the University of Cologne will host 17 CRCs, making it the highest number of CRCs at the UoC so far. According to our own calculations, we belong to the TOP 5 universities in Germany.

#### **Excellence Strategy**

The University of Cologne is participating in the new Excellence Strategy of the federal and state governments with seven new draft proposals for Clusters of Excellence (on top of the four EXC already running). A decision on full applications of the new initiatives will be announced in February 2024.

- Sharing a Planet in Peril (FU Berlin U Freiburg, MPI for the Study of Societies), Professor Catherine Rigby
- Code for Behavior<sup>1</sup> (DZNE, MPI for Neurobiology of Behavior), Professor Graziana Gatto (Speaker UoC)
- CeCo<sub>2</sub>M<sup>2</sup> Cluster of Excellence on CO<sub>2</sub> Management (RWTH Aachen. FZ Jülich), *Professor Stan Kopriva (Speaker UoC)*

In Germany, 143 draft proposals were submitted by 59 different universities.
